Recent Investigation News/Highlights

- On May 10th, 2014 PIM members Missy, Noah, and John along with Stevens Point Paranormal Club investigated Ashmore Estates in Illinois. Last year Ashmore Estates fell victim to a violent tornado that caused much damage to the building. Unfortunately many of the windows were broken and the roof was torn off. Many animals, especially birds, decided to make Ashmore their home. This made it difficult to conduct a controlled investigation. The night of PIM's investigation Ashmore was sold and put into very caring hands. Many renovations have been done since PIM's visit and the new owner has offered PIM and SPPC the opportunity to return under better conditions. We will return in September and are looking forward to it!
- On May 3rd PIM members John, Tony, and Mary investigated a private residence in Burlington WI. Many claims were made by the home owners including a blanket in the Master Bedroom was slowly pulled off the bed while the Female Client and her sister lay on the bed, numerous objects thrown in the apartment by an unknown source, orange colored liquid was found on wall in the Kitchen and Bathroom and green colored liquid was found on the Kitchen floor. During the investigation none of these things were witnessed but the client has continued to have claims of activity. Since PIM's investigation the client's were able to capture some of this phenomenon on video which PIM is currently analyzing. PIM plans to return to follow up on this investigation.
